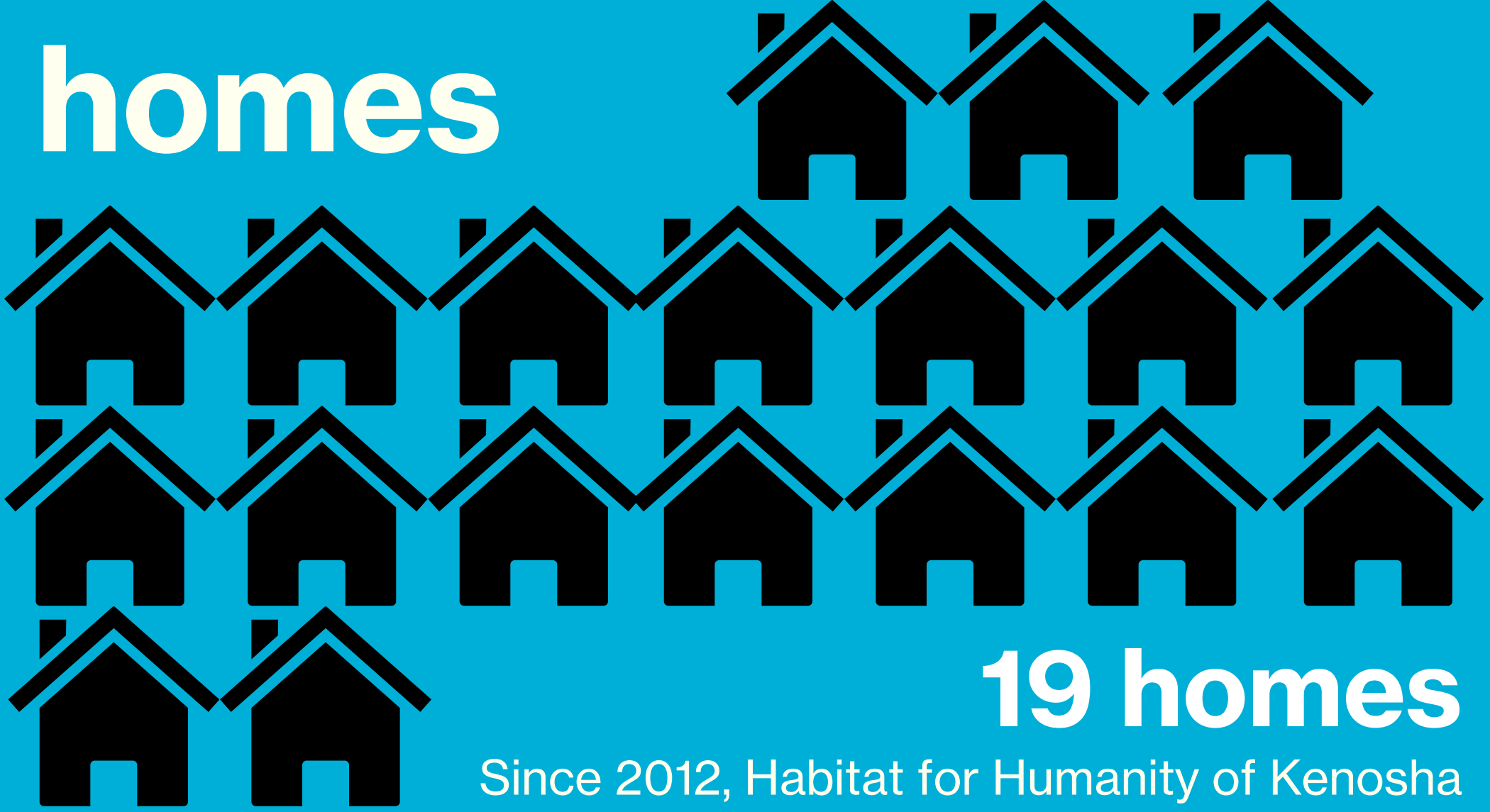

Since 2012, Habitat for Humanity of Kenosha has completed 16 new builds and 3 rehabs, with 6 more new builds currently in progress.

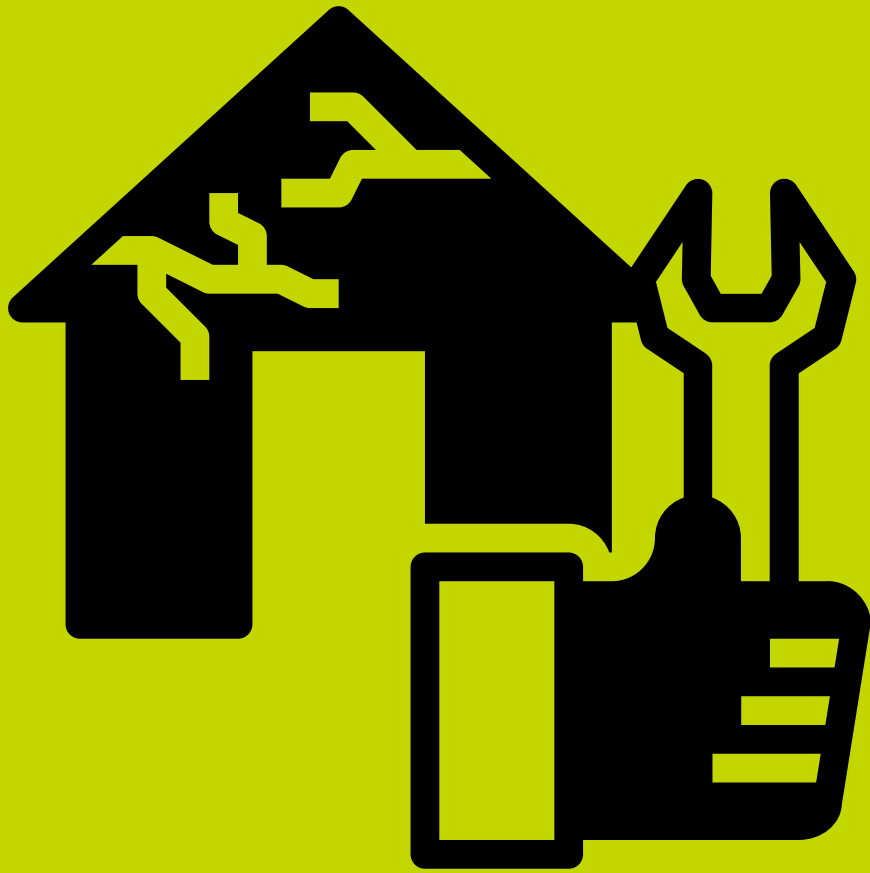
our families

Currently, we have 19 families now living in safe, decent, and affordable Habitat homes. Our homeowners earn below 80% of the local area median income. Approximately 95% of our homeowners are single mothers with young children.

In partnership with KAFASI, Habitat Kenosha has been repairing homes for seniors 60+ and veterans since 2022.

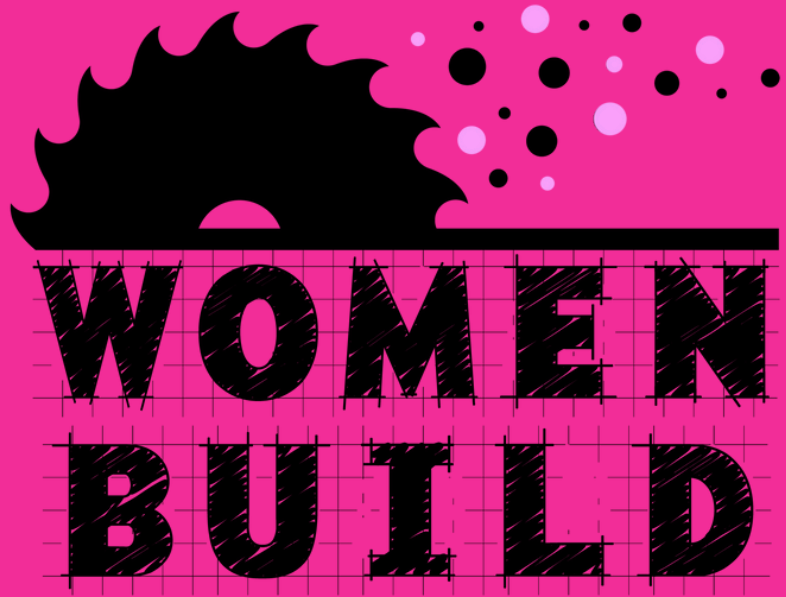

During Community Build Week, we collaborate with local organizations to gather funds, raise awareness, and assist local families in realizing their dream of homeownership.

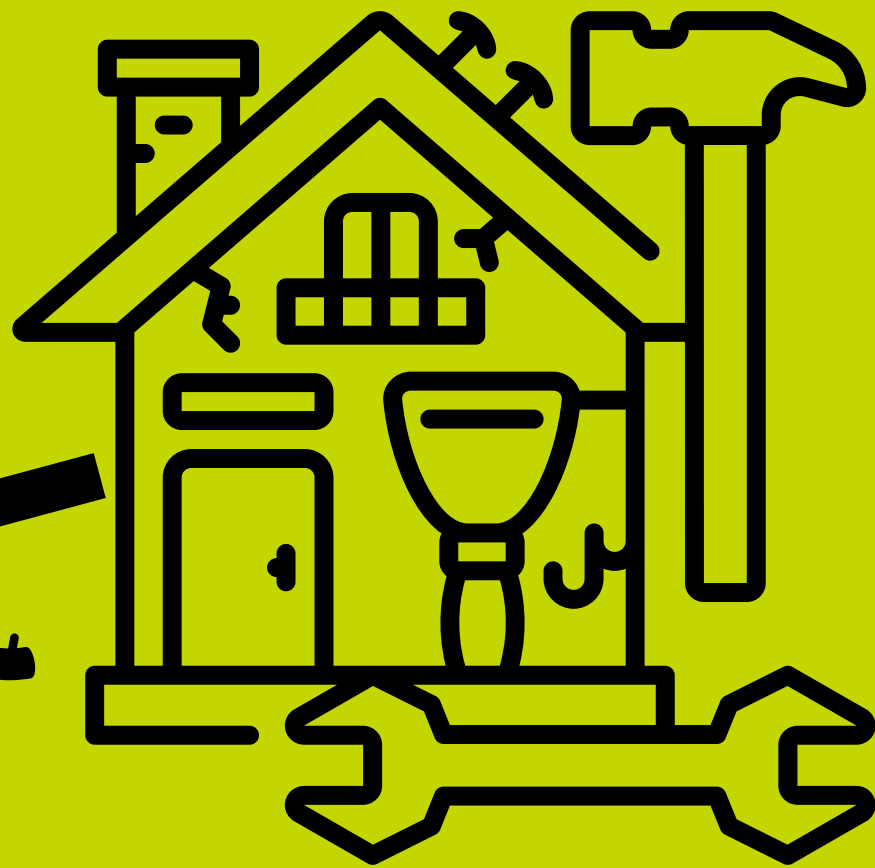

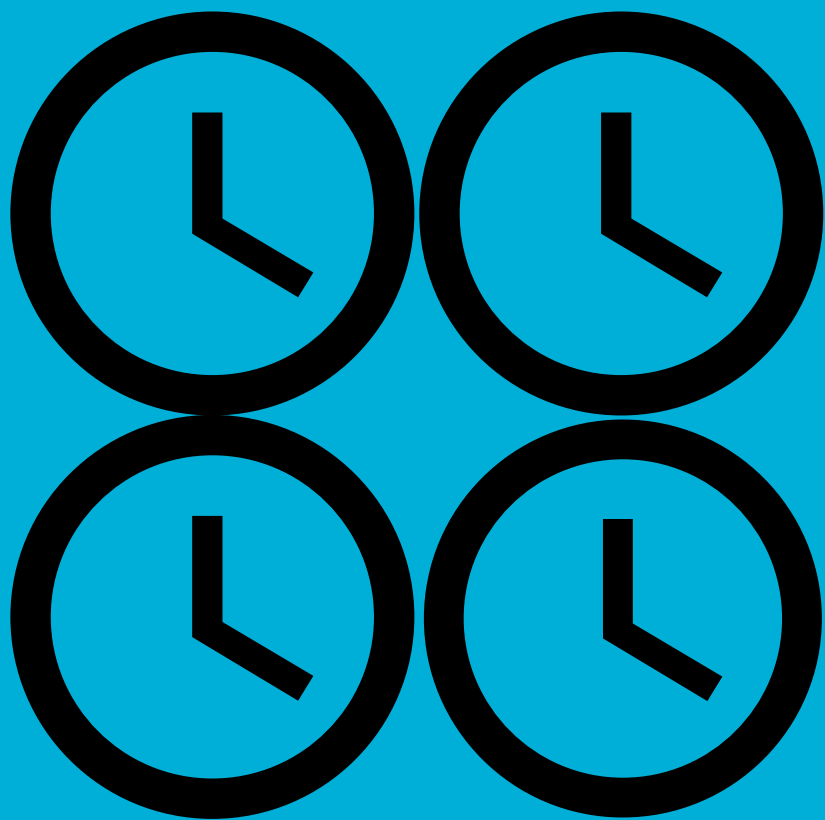

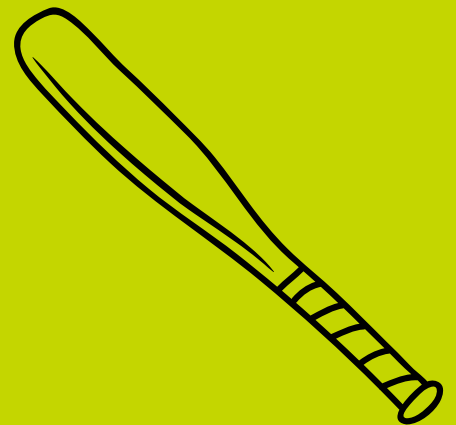
